Reasons

1. Destruction of Habitat

→ Ways of destroying habitat

*peop. destr. hab. to create resident areas/buildings to live

*clear land / farmers to grow crops

*fill land for agriculture

*dams-electric power

→Degradation of habitat

*not destroyed, but hab. got worse

*ex; oil spills, wat.poll., acid rain

Acid rain **\(\sigma** burning fossil fuels

2. Illegal wildlife trade

*Gov. laws protecting en.species but il.hunting go on

* hunt for food

*hunt chimp. to sell to zoos/medical exp. /pets- parrots

*hunt for specific parts-tigers for furs/elephants for hides/tusks

*to make souvenirs/works of art/make money

3. Overexploitation

*passenger pigeons in U.S.-so plentiful-3.5 billion in 18th cent.

*extinct at beg. of 20^{th} cent. \leftarrow overhunting for food/mostly for sport

*Brazilian nut tree-in danger ← overharvesting

4. Competition

2 types: domestic an. A introduced anim.

Domestic (cattle, horse, sheep, goat)

*threat to wild an. –compete for habitat

*Peop. hunt/trap/poison wild an. to protect livestock

*Ex: Wolf/near extinction

Introduced an: brought on purpose/by accident

*Ex: Rabbit -19th cent-brought to Australia



- *to hunt for sport
- *damaged hab. (anim. I plants)
- *Ex: Brown tree snake-accidentally –island of Guam/late 1940s
- *military cargo planes
- *destroyed bird pop.
- → Only humans can change this.
